Rules & Regulations

- All Vendor Applications are subject to approval by the Oro Agricultural Society Board of Directors.
- The 2019 Oro World's Fair is September 13th & 14th, 2019.
- The setup times are Thursday September 12th 12 noon to 7pm or Friday September 13th before 10am.
- The buildings will be open Friday 10am to 10pm and Saturday 10am to 4:45pm. You are responsible for the staffing of your booth during these times.
- Inside vendor spaces are 10' by 10'
- **Returning vendors may request space, however due to spacing requirements we cannot guarantee space requests.**
- Vendors must provide proof of liability insurance with application and sign the hold harmless agreement on the application.
- Food Vendors **must** provide a 2019 copy of the County Health Inspection certificate. Food Vendors also require a vendor license from the Township of Oro-Medonte. Contact them at 705-487-2171 or <https://www.oro-medonte.ca/>
- Vendors are expected to supply their own tables & necessary items for their display area.
- Indoor Vendors are limited to a maximum of 2 spaces.
- A detailed description of items to be sold must be provided.
- No Weapons or illegal substances are to be sold on fairgrounds.

- Any clothing/shirts sold are to be of a tasteful nature. This is a family event – so clothing should be suitable for all family members.

• The Fee Schedule is as follows:	<u>2019</u>
Indoor Space 10' by 10'	\$110.00 plus 13% HST
Outdoor Space for 20' by 20'	\$100.00 plus 13% HST
Anything over that is another \$4 per linear foot plus 13% HST	
Food Booth	\$350.00 plus 13% HST
Hydro is extra, if required	\$20.00 plus HST

- There is to be no smoking in any buildings. Failure to abide by this rule will result in you being asked to leave the property immediately.
- If you are selling any scented products, please be aware that some people may be sensitive to fragrances and please try to keep these to a minimum.
- In an effort to minimize traffic problems, there will be no parking inside the fairgrounds. Parking is available only in the parking lots specified by the parking attendants. For those less agile, please make arrangements prior to Thursday of the fair.
- The Oro Agricultural Society will not be responsible for any losses incurred during the 2019 fair.
- 2 vendor passes will be issued upon acceptance and receipt of PAYMENT of vendor fees. Additional passes may be purchased at \$10.00 each. **FOOD VENDORS ARE TO RECEIVE 4 PASSES.**
- Vendor passes must be shown at gates both days.
