



169th Oro World's Fair

Rules & Regulations

- All Vendor Applications are subject to approval by the Oro Agricultural Society Board of Directors.
- The 2023 Oro World's Fair is September 15th & 16th.
- The setup times are Thursday, September 14th 12:00 noon to 7:00 pm or Friday September 15th before 10:00 am.
- The buildings will be open Friday 10:00 am to 10:00 pm and Saturday 10:00 am to 4:45pm. You are responsible for the staffing of your booth during these times.
- Inside vendor spaces are 10' by 10'
- Returning vendors may request space, however due to spacing requirements we cannot guarantee space requests.
- Vendors must provide proof of third party liability insurance naming the Oro Agricultural Society as insured with their application and sign the Hold Harmless Agreement & Acknowledgement on the Vendor Invoice/Rental Agreement.
- Food Vendors **must** provide a 2023 copy of the County Health Inspection certificate.
- Vendors are expected to supply their own tables & necessary items for their display area.
- Indoor Vendors are limited to a maximum of 2 spaces.
- A detailed description of items to be sold must be provided on the Vendor Invoice/Rental Agreement
- No Weapons or illegal substances are to be sold on fairgrounds.

- Any clothing/shirts sold are to be of a tasteful nature. This is a family event – so clothing should be suitable for all family members.
- The Fee Schedule is as follows: 2023

Indoor Space 10' by 10'	\$110.00 plus 13% HST = \$124.30
Outdoor Space for 20' by 20'	\$100.00 plus 13% HST = \$113.00
Large Outdoor Space 40' by 40'	\$200.00 plus 13% HST = \$226.00
Food Booth	\$500.00 plus 13% HST = \$565.00
Hydro	\$ 20.00 plus 13% HST = \$ 22.60
- There is to be no smoking in any buildings. Failure to abide by this rule will result in being asked to leave the property immediately.
- If you are selling any scented products, please be aware that some people may be sensitive to fragrances and please try to keep these to a minimum.
- In an effort to minimize traffic problems, there will be no parking inside the fairgrounds. Parking is available only in the parking lots specified by the parking attendants. For those less agile, please make arrangements prior to Thursday of the fair.
- The Oro Agricultural Society will not be responsible for any losses incurred during the 2023 fair.
- 2 vendor passes will be issued upon acceptance of application. Additional passes may be purchased at \$10.00 each.
- Vendor passes must be shown at gates both days.
